
How to get to Gosforth Nature Reserve

The reserve is 3 miles north of Newcastle centre on the eastern side of Gosforth Park.







Parking at the reserve can be limited, especially on busy days, NHSN encourages sustainable travel to and from the reserve wherever possible.

On Foot

The reserve can be reached on foot from some local schools. There is a footpath alongside the A189 Salters Lane that goes past the reserve entrance.

By Private Coach/Minibus/Car

The reserve entrance is accessed off the A189 (Salter's Lane) between South Gosforth and West Moor. The reserve is not signposted and the entrance is easily missed but there are roundabouts at either end of the road for you to retrace your steps! There is ample parking outside the reserve entrance which is sufficient for at least one coach/bus. Post code for Satnav NE3 5EP.

By Public Transport

The nearest bus stops are:

- A189 Salter's Lane, Longbenton (about 10 mins walk).
- Benton Lane, West Moor (opposite community centre, about 10 mins walk).

For buses serving Newcastle, Longbenton, Killingworth and Cramlington.

The nearest Metro stations are Longbenton and Four Lane Ends but it is about 1.5 miles from there to the reserve.
