

## Upload observations

**1**. Click the plus button on the bottom right of the 'my observations' page.

2. Once you have chosen which media you are using, you will be taken to an 'edit observation' page were you can add more details about the species. Here you can:

- say what you have observed or see what the AI suggests
- Write down notes about your observation
- Select the date and time of your observation.
- Select if the observation was captive or cultivated
- Add projects you have joined

If you are unsure on the species you can add a broader category for example birds, fungi. People can see your observation and suggest an ID for you.

3. Check back in with your observation to see the data quality, ID suggestions, information of what you have observed.
